For this to be reached, we promote equalization of opportunities for people with disabilities within the community including all respective authorities, and provide various social services.

STORIES OF OUR CLIENTS

RUZENKA: I lost my sight 9 years ago. I used to sit at home without a possibility to return to society. I started working in the sheltered workshop 6 years ago and since that time every month has brought me more experiences than those years which I had spent at home. I took part in sewing and weaving courses and got a working place perfectly equipped regarding my disability.



LUBOS: "My family used to assist me with every little thing. Since I have started visiting the day care centre, I have learnt how to do the washing, how to prepare simple meal, how to make coffee and much more. I have become more self-sufficient and assumed part of the housework".

SOCIAL CONSULTING

Are you or your family member disabled, facing temporary handicap, in the course of recovery after medical intervention or a senior searching for advice on:

- \approx how to start the process of inclusion?
- $\approx~$ how to adjust accommodation and working place to be suitable for someone with a handicap?
- \approx how to communicate with central and local authorities while searching support?
- \approx which compensatory and rehabilitation devices are suitable for you?

Our social counsellors help people with handicap, seniors and their family members to navigate complicated situations by provision of necessary information, referrals to follow-up services providers, facilitation of communication with authorities and advices and recommendations on how to tackle arisen problems and issues.







SOCIAL REHABILITATION

Are you or your family member disabled, facing temporary handicap, in the course of recovery after medical intervention or a senior searching for:

- \approx support to return to normal life?
- \approx professional assistance to practice how to cook, iron or do the laundry in order to become more self-sufficient when assuming household chores?
- \approx professional assistance to practice shopping, negotiation with authorities or a visit of a cinema in order to become independent of your caregivers?

The team of our SOCIAL WORKERS creates a HEALTHY SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT for people with disabilities and temporary handicap, people with mental illness and seniors to learn and practice behaviour in everyday situations thus helping them to restore or form relationships, avoid isolation and achieve independence.







DAY CARE CENTRE

Is your family member a disabled person and you do not want him/her to be:

- \approx isolated while being given care only at home?
- \approx to be placed to a nursing home or a psychiatric hospital because you do not have capacity to provide him/her a round-a-clock care?

Our DAY CARE CENTRE is intended for people whose capabilities are limited, particularly in the areas of personal care and household care and who cannot live at home on a daily basis without someone else's assistance. Provided social stimulation and recreational activities improve or maintain physical and cognitive functions of people with disabilities while their caregivers are enabled to work or to have a break from their caregiving responsibilities.







SHELTERED WORKSHOP

Are you or your family member disabled:

- $\approx~$ and as such not able to compete in open job market?
- \approx looking for a supportive environment where physically or mentally challenged persons can acquire new skills and experience?

Our WORKSHOP employs persons with disability, who would otherwise become excluded from work opportunities. Work in our ceramic and textile workshops enables our employees to acquire job skills and vocational experience necessary for their further work integration. We produce handmade souvenirs, gifts and complementary goods and/or inputs for production companies.









RENTAL SERVICE OF COMPENSATORY AND REHABILITATION DEVICES

Are you or your family member disabled, facing temporary handicap, in the course of recovery after medical intervention or a senior searching for the possibility:

- \approx to try the respective wheelchairs, positioning beds, walkers or other compensatory or rehabilitation devices to find out which is the most suitable one before making decision about its purchase?
- $\approx~$ to rent a compensatory or rehabilitation devices while facing only a temporary disability?



Our Barrier-free centre comprising multifunctional conference hall up to 50 persons, barrier-free accommodation up to 10 persons in two self-contained flats, an equipped exercise room and both ceramic and textile workshops.

OUR FUTURE

Our MAIN OBJECTIVE is to increase diversity and amount of the services and activities we provide to the people with disability and seniors, further promote their social inclusion and raise public disability awareness.

Our SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE is to complete the reconstruction of former Paulaner cloister in Nová Paka in order to restore its original function; to serve ill, disabled and senior community members.

In 2011 the reconstruction of a side agricultural building of the former Paulaner cloister compound was successfully completed and was opened as the Centre without barriers.

The project budget was ca. 1 250 000 Euro.



The construction of the main Paulaner cloister building has yet to start.

The project is prepared and the process of fundraising has started.
